



Holy Spirit Protocol

A guideline to how we should live our lives outside the 4 walls of FCC.

1. Watch your mouth gate. Know that your tongue is a powerful thing and needs to continuously speak life and not death.
2. Help others. Jesus was the prime example of this. He gave selflessly to others even to the point of his own life.
3. Watch your attitude. We must carry a good and thankful attitude all of the time, even when feeling a little pressure.
4. Walk in humility. Again, Jesus was the ultimate example of this when He came down from heaven to be a man.
5. Respecting leadership in the church. This requires humility. If you have an issue with something, follow the right steps to get it resolved.
6. Do not host habitual sin. Jesus needs to be the center of your life. He is worthy of night and day worship.
7. Understand that Worship is done the entire week, not just Sunday and Wednesday. This does not mean singing to your neighbors. This means doing the right thing all the time. When nobody is looking. In or out of church. With your unsaved friends. At Work. Alone with Jesus.
8. Offer encouragement to uplift and edify. (1 Thessalonians 5:11)
9. Encourage one another to show love, even to your enemies. (Matthew 25:35-40)
